

Thriving for Thirty Years...Thanks to You!



As 2019 winds to a close, we can't help but reflect on three decades of this amazing organization. In the 30 years since its founding, Days End Horse Farm Horse Rescue has remained highly committed to its mission of intervention, education, and outreach. And we couldn't have done it without some special help along the way, thanks to a myriad of supporters. Every dollar donated has made a difference in saving the life of an animal.

"It's an incredible feeling to see DEFHR not only enduring after 30 years, but thriving and continuing to grow, thanks our incredible donors and volunteers and this community," said DEFHR's Chief Executive Officer Erin Clemm Ochoa at our recent [holiday party](#). "It's because of them that DEFHR is celebrating 30 years and because of them that we look forward to the next 30!"

Since 1989, over 2,500 horses have been saved from all over Maryland and the surrounding states. Of these horses, 98% were successfully rehabilitated and adopted into new homes—an accomplishment that makes us incredibly proud. DEFHR has gone from a small non-profit sheltering a few horses to a full-scale, well-respected national rescue and rehabilitation facility working with up to 150 horses annually.

Here are some highlights of 2019:

- We matched over 40 horses with adopters, which allowed even more horses to come into our rehabilitation program.
- We educated hundreds of children, adults, students, and animal professionals through internships, children's programs, and hands-on trainings.
- We are the proud winner of the Best Camp and a finalist for Best Nonprofit in Frederick's Best of Best Contest.
- This year we launched a new outreach program and started to take one of our horses to libraries, assisted-living homes, memory-care facilities, schools, and hospice centers to visit with residents and students, providing them with a memory and smile they won't soon forget.

And, of course, none of this would be possible without our generous supporters. As a 501c3, there are so many **different ways to donate** to DEFHR. 


How Else Can You Help?
