The **New York Empire (NYE)** team scored its first win of the **2019 Global Champions League (GCL)** series at the tour’s recent stop in Valkenswaard, the Netherlands. Teammates **Daniel Bluman** on **Ladriano Z** and **Spencer Smith** on **Theodore Manciais** got the team off to a strong start with two clean performances in the opening round. In round two, Bluman and Ladriano Z repeated their clear while team owner **Georgina Bloomberg** rode **Quibelle** to a clean trip. The regular season of the GCL series concluded at the debut of the **New York City stop** September 27–29, while the **GCL Super Cup** takes place November 21–24 in Prague, Czech Republic.

The **Adequan® FEI North American Youth Championships**, presented by **Gotham North**, returned to **Old Salem Farm** in North Salem, New York, with great success. Teams from the

United States, Canada and Mexico competed at the children’s, junior, and young rider levels in show jumping, and the junior and young rider levels in dressage. In show jumping, the team from Canada won the young rider gold, while the Mexican team claimed junior gold, and USHJA Zones 4 and 10 joined forces for the gold medal in the children’s division. Sisters **Sophie Gochman** riding **Carola BH** and **Mimi Gochman** on **Street Hassle BH** finished as individual gold medalists in the young rider and junior divisions, respectively, while **Isaac Parada Urtaza** of Mexico captured the children’s individual gold with **Tarnot**. In the dressage, USDF Region 1 claimed team young rider gold, while USDF Region 4 took home the gold medal from the junior team competition. **Callie Jones** earned individual gold medals in the young rider Individual and freestyle tests riding **Don Philippo**, while **Annelise Klepper** won gold in the junior individual and freestyle tests on **Happy Texas Moonlight**.

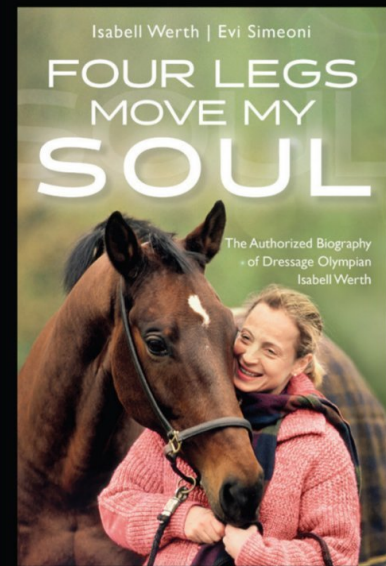

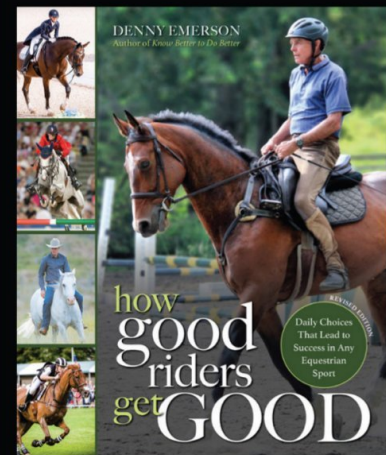
