Lucy Deslauriers of New York, NY, was originally named the traveling reserve with Hester, but replaced Ward when he was forced to withdraw Contagious due to injury.

Apple Knoll Farm of New Boston, NH, traveled to Devon, PA, for the 2019 USEF Junior Hunter National Championships - East and the Hunterdon Cup Equitation Classic - East. Kelley McCormick rode her own Eternity in the 3'3" Large Junior Hunter 16-17 division, taking twenty-fifth in the classic, twenty-sixth in the handy, and twenty-fifth overall. Dominika Silvestri rode her own Nice in the 3'6" Large Junior Hunter 16-17 division, taking twenty-seventh in the classic and twenty-eighth in the handy and overall, and the Hunterdon Cup.

Also in Pennsylvania for Junior Hunter Finals was Ellie Ferrigno of Newton, CT. Ferrigno and Wolfstone Stables & Sales Inc.'s Cleopatra's Smile claimed the Overall Grand Championship in the 3'6" section with a total score of 258 points, earning the Monarch International Perpetual Trophy. The duo topped the Small Junior Hunter 16-17 3'6" classic and handy, and took twelfth in the under saddle, to take the division championship as well.
