Santiago Lambre and Dingeman Top the \$75,000 Agricon Kubota Superstore Grand Prix

Santiago Lambre (MEX) claimed another big Winter Spectacular win on Saturday, March 20, in the \$75,000 Agricon Kubota Superstore Grand Prix at World Equestrian Center – Ocala aboard Dingeman, a 13-year-old KWPN gelding owned by Aurora Rangel de Alba. "I was lucky to be the last to go in the jump-off so that I could see how fast I needed to go," said Lambre. "I took all of the risks from the beginning of the course because I saw that everyone was trying to be faster than Aaron Vale and most ended up one second behind. I know Dingeman very well, so I know he can go fast and clear the jumps. He is a winner." Aaron Vale (USA) and Major took second and Sharn Wordley (NZL) and Casper jumped to third.

Jeffrey Ayers and his own Cartel earned top honors in the \$20,000 WEC Hunter Derby 3'6"-3'9" on Friday, March 19, on a total score of 185.5. "I was really happy with my horse," said Ayers. "He was very consistent in both rounds, which is something that we've been working on. In previous weeks, our first round has been a bit better than our second round, and he was very good in both rounds today. I am probably the oldest rider out there today at 61 years old, so a win makes me happy!"

Tracey Fenney topped the \$15,000 WEC Derby 3' Open with MTM Animated, and Addison McQuaker and Golden Ticket earned their second \$15,000 WEC Derby 3' Non Pro win.

During Winter Spectacular #12, World Equestrian Center – Ocala will offer the same three hunter derbies on Friday, March 26, with each awarding \$75,000 in prize money to wrap the circuit.
