Maximize participation with easy access to recycling bins that are clearly labeled. Ensure items placed in bins are clean and do not contaminate other materials.

2. Repair items before replacing.

Repair wheelbarrows, reinforce broken pitchforks with twine, and replace a single zipper rather than the whole pair of boots. Over time, many items will break with use. Repair what you can and keep items in circulation as long as possible. When purchasing tools, choose products with easily replaceable parts so you can repair






