Two-Day Equine Cruelty Investigator Training



On Wednesday, September 22, and Thursday, September 23, 2021, DEFHR will host a two-day training for equine welfare professionals designed to help animal cruelty investigators become confident while working with and handling equines. This handson session is designed to educate investigators about how to identify when a horse's needs are not being met.

Topics covered include body condition scoring, dental and hoof neglect, minimum standards of care, emergency response techniques, how to take vitals, and more.

Featured Horse of the Month: Miss Madeline






Fifteen-year-old Hanoverian mare, 15.1hh
