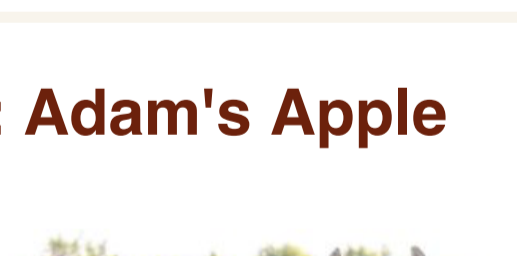


"Equine Rescues Navigate Legal Limbo To Give Horses a Bright Future"

In January 2021, DEFHR took in 19 critically ill horses. While all were in poor condition, they were fully rehabilitated. Despite their recovery, these horses cannot enter into training or be put up for adoption until the legal case against their owner is resolved. This creates a burden for the horses who must wait longer for their forever home. The burden extends to the rescues, too. The care for these horses alone is expected to cost DEFHR \$146,000 by the time the case is closed. Featured Horse of the Month: Adam's Apple

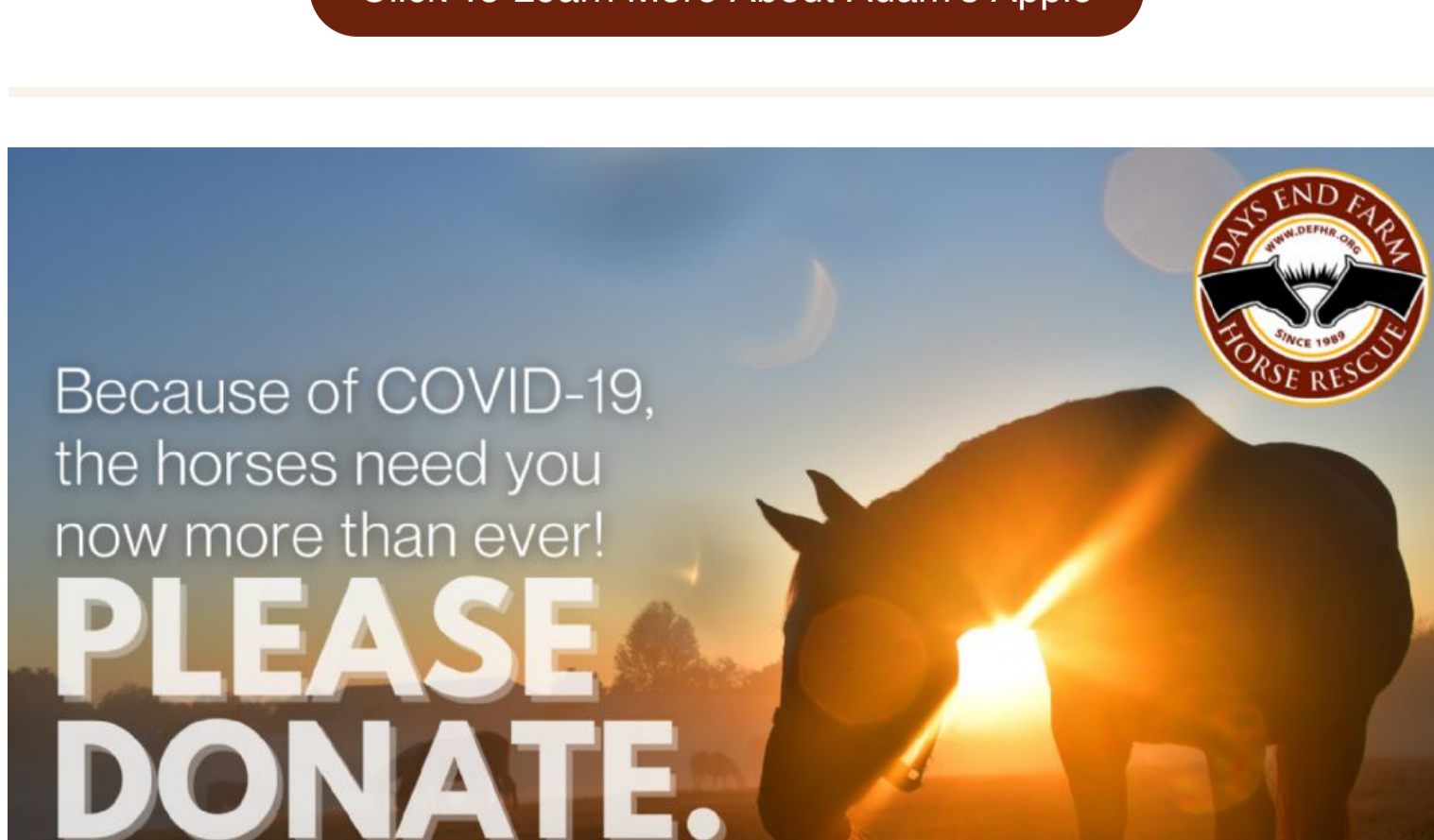


21-year-old Appaloosa gelding, 14.3hh
