



July 10, 2022 – Mill Spring, NC – Michael Murphy of Apopka, FL, and Catoki's Son Z, owned by Esperanza Imports LLC, zipped through the jump-off in a time of 34.37 seconds to win Sunday's \$25,000 Tryon Resort Grand Prix in Tryon Stadium. Thirty entries challenged the Alan Wade (IRL) course design, with six pairs returning for the jump-off. Murphy acknowledged that he had almost not entered the class and decided to take a shot with the 13-year-old Zangersheide gelding (Catoki x Vanis) at the last minute. "It's a full-circle thing.
