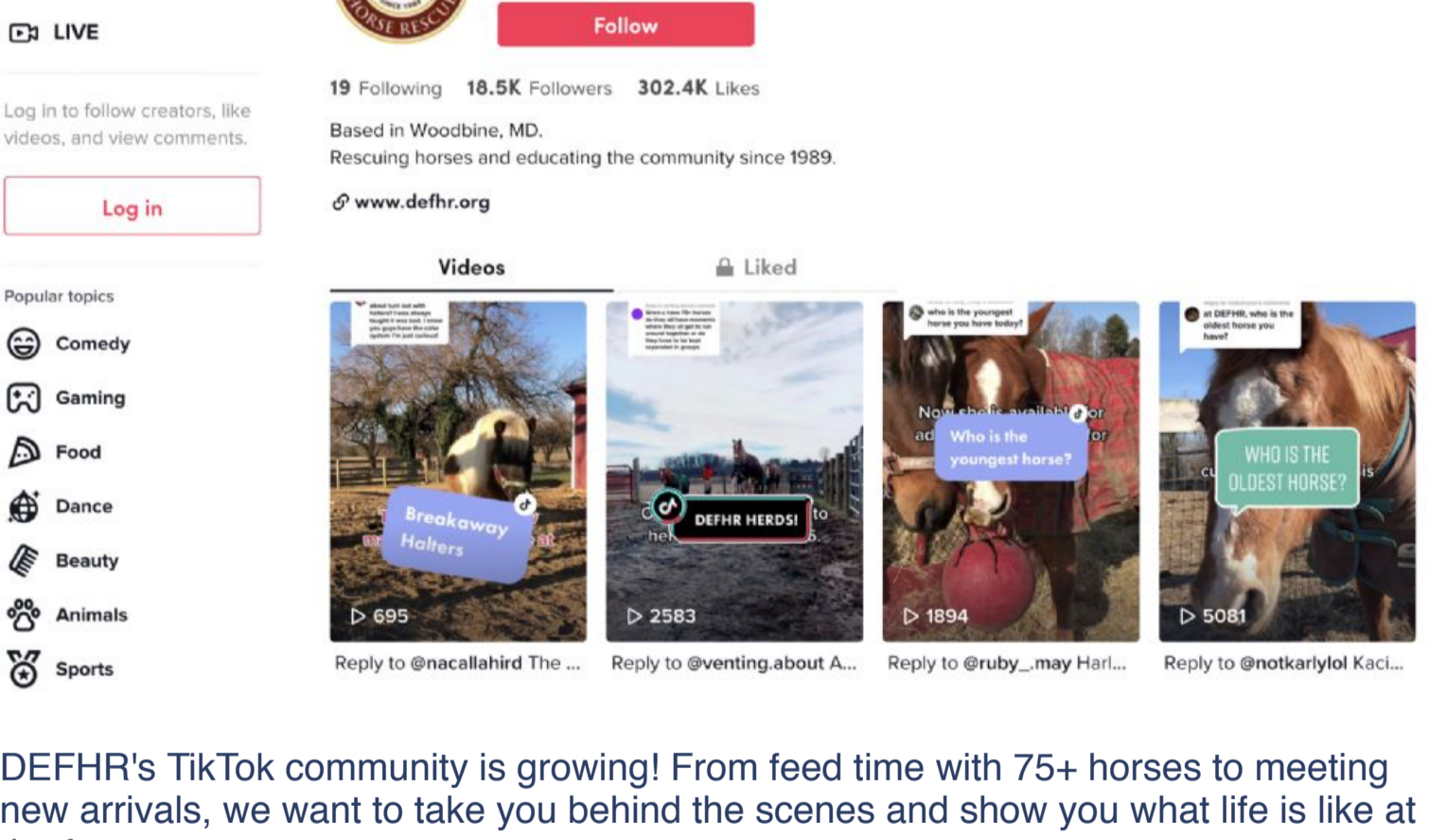
Apply for DEFHR's Full-Time Barn Assistant Position

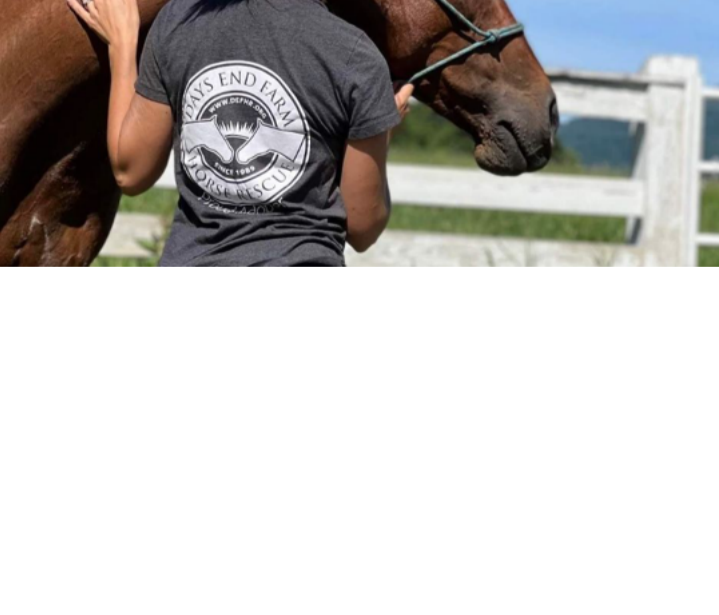

Featured Horse of the Month: Sterling



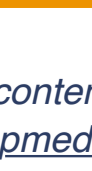
14-year-old Thoroughbred gelding, 16.2hh
