Remembering an Equine Welfare Pioneer



DEFHR staff, volunteers, and its Board of Directors were saddened to learn of the passing of Kathy Schwartz-Howe, the organization's co-founder and executive director for 24 years.

Kathy, 71, of Woodbine, Maryland, passed on March 6, 2023, following a battle with Alzheimer's.

A pioneer for equine welfare, Kathy and her then-husband Allen were one of the first to provide resources and education to law enforcement officials and animal advocates. Kathy's mission was to make horses accessible to the community by creating a welcoming facility where anyone could learn and receive hands-on with these incredible animals. This mission comes to fruition on a daily basis at DEFHR. The organization remains committed to creating a culture of humane care and compassion for all equines in an effort to end the vicious cycle of neglect and abuse.

Thousands of horses have her to thank for their second chances and countless people are indebted to her for her contribution to the advancement of equine welfare.
