

I grew up riding western as a kid and always loved being around horses.



Digital radiographs may be taken at the barn or at the clinic and are assessed by Palm Beach Equine Clinic's boardcertified radiologist. **Endoscopy:** An endoscope is an instrument that allows veterinarians an in-depth look inside the body. 

