Swan Song Show Performance Earns Sportsmanship Award for Young Rider With an Admirable Attitude

In September 2024, the <u>Experience Equestrian League</u> (ExEL) show at the Germantown Charity Horse Show grounds in Germantown, TN, was the very last for the partnership of 11year-old Carlyn Burns and her beloved pony, Mikey. She knew she was outgrowing him, and the family had made the tough decision for the 18-year-old Mikey to step down to an easier job following the show.

It was a day tinged with sadness for Carlyn, but she made it memorable by winning the Equitation Challenge out of a field of more than 40 starters and was second in the Hunter Derby. It was not just her results in the ring that garnered Carlyn the Connaway & Associates Junior Sportsmanship Award that day; she was spotted in the barn helping her barn mates and supportively cheering them on ringside.

"This award will always have a special place in my heart because of the memories that are tied to it with Mikey," said Carlyn, whose meaningful three-year partnership with Mikey was crowned by the sportsmanship award. "Being around horses has taught me a lot about friendship, responsibility, hard work, and dedication. It has also taught me to have patience. That can be hard when you're out in the big arena, and it's just you and the horse, but those moments are what has built me to be a better rider."



Harry Charles


